10th Oct 2024, Kathmandu From May 16-19, 2024, a Regional Seminar on Environmental Sustainability and Climate Action took place at Happy Hill Resort in Kathmandu, Nepal. Organized by CWISH and the National Youth Network for Sustainable Development (NYNSD), the event brought together 25 enthusiastic young people from Nepal, India, Tajikistan, and Pakistan, each showcasing their unique cultures.

The seminar aimed to deepen understanding of how countries in South Asia can work together on environmental policies and encourage youth participation in climate action. Participants included social and political leaders, activists, and professionals who facilitated discussions throughout the event.

A key moment of the seminar was the unveiling of a manifesto that outlines important steps to combat climate change, promote renewable energy, protect biodiversity, and involve communities in sustainable practices. Youth representatives from the four countries signed the manifesto, which was presented to Jagdish Ayer, a member of the National Youth Council.
